(Graduates unavailable for employment means the graduates who, after graduation, die, experience a permanent or indefinite disability, are called to active military duty, are international students that leave the United States or do not have a visa allowing employment in the United States, or are continuing their education at an institution under the same ownership).
- **“Graduates Employed in the Field”** means graduates who are gainfully employed, whose employment has been reported, and for whom the institution has documented verification of employment on or before November 30, 2021.
- **“Placement Rate Employed in the Field”** is calculated by dividing the number of graduates gainfully employed in the field by the number of graduates available for employment.
